

NOTICE OF DECISION OF THE VACANCY PROCEDURE COMMITTEE

To be displayed as prominently as possible at the church building for seven days, posted publicly on website or social media, and by email or letter and/or by phone so as to ensure that all members of the congregation receive intimation in some form or other

Notice is hereby given that the Vacancy Procedure Committee of the Presbytery of Glasgow makes the following proposal in relation to the vacant charge of King's Park.

To grant permission to the charge of King's Park to call a minister on the basis of Reviewable Charge and to invite the Faith Nurture Forum to determine, as has Presbytery, that such permission to call on the basis of reviewable charge constitutes an exception in terms of section 31 of the Deliverance of the Faith Nurture Forum agreed at the General Assembly 2021 under section 9(2) of Act VII 2003 and that accordingly permission to call should be granted and remain extant for a period of two years from the grant of such permission.

These actions will proceed unless at least four persons, who are either communicant members of this congregation of King's Park or full members of Presbytery, together or separately, submit to the Interim Presbytery Clerk a request for this proposal to be considered at the next Ordinary Meeting of the Presbytery.

by Monday 12th July 2021. If four valid requests are received, then the proposed course of action will be suspended and the approval of Presbytery will be required.
